

# **YCL Responsibilities**

Be HELPFUL. Ask ward leaders if there is something that needs done in camp.

Be WATCHFUL. Who needs a friend? Reach out, be a friend.

Be EARLY. Please come early to our camp gathering times so we can start on time.

Be READY. Start the meeting/activity on time. **Music**: Be early to each gathering and start leading the group in camp songs. Check in with Sister Eppich during activity time.

**Age Adventures**: Check in with your age group leader. Is there anything to prepare?

Activities: Check in with leaders. Where do they need extra hands?

**Crafts**: Check in with Sis. Casper & Sis. Wilson at the craft tables. Where/when do they need extra help?

**Evening Activities**: Gather supplies for Tuesday night FHE and deliver them to each ward camp. Help teach line dances for the dance party and check in with Sister Andelin for Thursday evening.

\*\*\*ALL YCLs ATTEND OUR YCL MEETING EVERY NIGHT AT 10 PM AT THE LOWER AMP. We will check in from the day, answer any questions for the next day, and know where we could use more help.

# **CAMP – EMERGENCY PLAN**

<u>Warning Signal</u> – The emergency signal is one long and two short blasts on a mega phone. If you hear this signal, go to the flagpole area for instructions.

<u>EVACUATION</u> – If evacuation is necessary, a staff member will tell you which direction to evacuate. Leaders and YW should evacuate in an orderly fashion. Do not return to your campsite to collect gear.

<u>MEDICAL EMERGENCY</u> – If a medical emergency occurs and 911 is called, please let Kindra Whitemarsh or Michelle Schultz know so we can help direct the emergency vehicle to the site. Send someone to the entrance to lead the emergency vehicle to your site.

# CAMP RULES The "Yes" List 💿

- 1. Come to have a great time!
- 2. Reach out and minister to someone else.
- 3. Please be modest at all times.
- 4. Everyone does their own camp duties. Help each other!
- 5. Flip flops may be worn in the showers only.
- 6. Respect others property.
- 7. Everyone must be in camp boundaries at all times.
- 8. Adults should know where each young woman in their unit is.
- 9. Follow the schedule, attend all classes and participate in activities.
- 10. Water shoes in the river.
- 11. Sleep in your own tent and stay there after tent check.
- 12. Young Women will be sent home for inappropriate behavior. Parents will be required to pick up their child if needed.
- 13. REPORT ANY EMERGENCIES TO STAKE STAFF!!

# CAMP RULES

- 14. No charging devices at the pavilion or bathrooms. No devices at all in bathrooms.
- 15. **<u>NEVER</u>** leave fires unattended. See that they are completely out before leaving your camp for any meeting or activity.
- 16. No candy or food in your tent, suitcase, pockets, backpacks, etc. There are critters around.
- 17. **NO** bare feet.
- 18. **NEVER** get into someone else's suitcase or equipment without permission.
- 19. <u>NO PRANKS!!</u> Do not do anything that will cause damage to personal property or someone's self-esteem.
- 20. Use buddy system. Don't go anywhere alone.

\*ALL campers PLEASE check out the lost and found (at pavilion) to retrieve personal items BEFORE checking out


\*Pick up ALL trash on the ground in your unit and on the trails leading to your unit
